## Facts about our course

The M.D. programme in Italy lasts for 6 years where a sum of 360 credits (CFUs) must be reached in order to graduate. The 360 credits are divided into 36 exams over a course of 6 years. The degree is classified as a "Single Cycle Master's Degree". After graduating, our students will be qualified to practice as Medical Doctors in the European Union and will also be eligible to apply for the recognition of their studies to study abroad
