**A CALL REGARDING THE AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS INVOLVED IN
DIDACTIC SUPPORT ACTIVITIES
Academic year 2016/2017**

The President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery,

concerning the resolution of 21/03/2017 of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery,

hereby announces

a selection for the 2016/2017 academic year **regarding the awarding of** n.27 scholarships of 500 euros for a total of 30 hours of teaching work for the following integrated courses or modules: Physics and Statistics, Chemistry and Introductory Biochemistry, Human anatomy 1, Applied biology and genetics, Histology, Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Human anatomy II, Immunology and immunopathology, Physiology, Microbiology, General pathology I, General pathology II, Laboratory medicine, Clinical symptomatology, Human sciences, Systemic pathology I, Pharmacology I, Pharmacology II, Systemic pathology II, Public health, Anatomic pathology I, Anatomic pathology II, Systemic pathology III, Neurological sciences, Diseases of the Musculoskeletal system, Diagnostic imaging and radiotherapy, Psychiatry. Only students who are enrolled in the one-cycle Master Degree course in **Medicine and Surgery** are entitled to participate in the above-mentioned call. A scholarship will be assigned for teaching support in each of the courses where the winning student must provide assistance.

Art.1 - Requirements

Students who are entitled to participate must have enrolled before **31st December 2016, or in other foreseen or regulated cases, by the established dates:**

- a)** all students who are not involved in a supplementary year (fuori corso) (taking into consideration the academic year in which the student enrolled for the first time in the degree course of Medicine and Surgery) and have regularly paid their university taxes.
- b)** students who have an average exam vote of at least 24/30 (the marks obtained in exams taken in other degree course, universities and during Erasmus periods will not be taken into consideration in the calculation of the average score)

The following are excluded from the selection:

- students who have not paid and registered their university taxes by the foreseen deadline;
- students who have been involved in disciplinary action and/or have a criminal record.

The scholarships are compatible with the general pay earned by part-time student collaborators and that earned by students who have won a tutorship (ex-art. 2 of the Ministerial Decree 198/2003) and the exemption from the specific fee (call 23/11/2016).

Art.2 - Calculation of the selection ranking list

To compile the ranking order, the evaluation of the lecturers will be taken into consideration together with the marks obtained in the exams taken by 5/03/2017. The ranking lists will be laid out in descending order according to the evaluation of the lecturers and the marks obtained in the exam for which the application has been presented. In cases of equal rank, the arithmetic average of the marks obtained will be considered. **In ex aequo situations**, the younger student will be considered first.

Art.3 - Commission

The compilation of the ranking list will be the responsibility of a Commission comprising n. 3 lecturers of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery and a member of the administrative staff appointed by the President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery.

Art. 4 - Application procedure

Applications (in Italian or English) must be sent by mail as attached pdf to this address medschool@uniroma2.it to the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and the President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery, compiled on unheaded paper (carta libera) according to the instructions described below, between 25th March and 5th April 2017, using self-certification in accordance with art. 46 and 47 of the Decree of the President of the Republic of 28.12.2000 n. 445. In e-mail object please specify the call you want to participate.

In the application process, the applicant must declare:

In the application form, the applicant must declare:

- a) Name, Surname, Place and date of birth;

- b) tax number (Codice fiscale);
- c) if they have been involved in disciplinary sanctions;
- d) whether or not they have a criminal record;
- e) a telephone number or email where they can be contacted;
- f) they are enrolled in the one-cycle Master Degree course in **Medicine and Surgery** of the Università degli Studi di Roma "Tor Vergata", providing a complete list of completed and officially registered exams by 05/03/2017. This self-certification will be checked by the university administration;
- g) a maximum of three applications (in order of preference) are permitted, relative **only** to teaching positions where exams have been given in our Medicine and Surgery course and officially registered.
- h) indicate the IBAN code of their bank account - **no payments will be made to third parties.**
- i) Date and signature

Art. 5 - Ranking list

The ranking list will be published on the Degree Course website (www.medschool.uniroma2.it). It will be possible to request a review of the list within 10 days of publication. After this date, the final and definitive ranking list will be published.

Art. 6 - The didactics

The teaching support activities will be carried out in the form of lessons, seminars, exam simulations, explanations on demand in the classroom by no later than 31st July 2017 unless derogations are otherwise stipulated.

Art. 7 - Collection of scholarships

Information regarding the relative distribution of the scholarships will be made available through a notice published on the website www.medschool.uniroma2.it of the Degree Course. Payments will take place on termination of the service and following the consignment of a written report to the Presidency of the Medicine and surgery course.
