A CALL REGARDING THE AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS INVOLVED IN INFORMATIC ACTIVITIES

Academic year 2018/2019

The President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery,

concerning the resolution of 05/02/2019 of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery,

hereby announces

a selection for the 2018/2019 academic year **regarding the awarding of** n.1 scholarship of 800 euros for the management of social media regarding the Medicine and Surgery course. Only students who are enrolled in the one-cycle Master Degree course in **Medicine and Surgery from the 1**st to the 6th year are entitled to participate in the above-mentioned call.

Art.1 - Requirements

Students who are entitled to participate must have enrolled before 31st of December 2018, or in other foreseen or regulated cases, by the established dates:

- a) all students who are not involved in a supplementary year (fuori corso) (taking into consideration the academic year in which the student enrolled for the first time in the degree course of Medicine and Surgery) and have regularly paid their university taxes.
- **b)** students who have an average exam vote of at least 26/30 (the marks obtained in exams taken in other degree course, universities and during Erasmus periods will not be taken into consideration in the calculation of the average score)

The following are excluded from the selection:

- students who have not paid and registered their university taxes by the foreseen deadline;
- students who have been involved in disciplinary action and/or have a criminal record.
- Students in Erasmus or abroad for thesis with a grant issued from our course.

The scholarships are compatible with the general pay earned by part-time student collaborators and that earned by students who have won a tutorship (ex-art. 2 of the Ministerial Decree 198/2003).

Art.2 - Calculation of the selection ranking list

To compile the ranking order will be taken into consideration the average only of the marks obtained in the exams taken by 10/03/2018 by our university (marks taken in Erasmus will not taken into consideration).

The ranking lists will be laid out in descending order according to the following criteria:

The students:

Must be able of working with both Facebook and Instagram social media,

must demonstrate that is able to prepare and publish posts;

Must demonstrate is able to operate with photo-editing programmes;

Must have high level of English written language;

Must have a previous experience with Facebook creator studio;

Must be able to use advanced technological media.

Minimum targets to be reached:

1 post/week/platform;

Production and maintenance of advertising campaign;

Public relations (answer to mail and be on chats)

Edit and publish photo on all extra courses

Publish leaflet related to conferences where our course is involved

Publish and give an account about all the stages made by our students both in hospitals and abroad

Publish report on scientific activities of our students and professors and trheir scientific works

Art.3 - Commission

The compilation of the ranking list will be the responsibility of a Commission comprising n. 3 lecturers of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery and a member of the administrative staff appointed by the President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery.

Art. 4 - Application procedure

Applications (in Italian or English) must be sent by mail as attached pdf to this address medschool@uniroma2.it to the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and the President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery, compiled on unheaded paper (carta libera) according to the instructions described below, between the $1^{\rm st}$ of June and $15^{\rm th}$ of June 2019, using self-certification in accordance with art. 46

and 47 of the Decree of the President of the Republic of 28.12.2000 n. 445. In e-mail object please specify the call you want to participate.

In the application process, the applicant must declare:

In the application form, the applicant must declare:

- a) Name, Surname, Place and date of birth;
- b) tax number (Codice fiscale);
- c) if they have been involved in disciplinary sanctions;
- d) whether or not they have a criminal record;
- e) a telephone number or email where they can be contacted;
- f) they are enrolled in the one-cycle Master Degree course in **Medicine and**Surgery of the Università degli Studi di Roma "Tor Vergata", providing a
 complete list of completed and officially registered exams by 28th/02/2019.
 This self-certification will be checked by the university administration;
- g) a maximum of three applications (in order of preference) are permitted, relative **only** to teaching positions where exams have been given in our Medicine and Surgery course and officially registered.
- h) indicate the IBAN code of their bank account no payments will be made to third parties.
- i) Date and signature

Art. 5 - Ranking list

The ranking list will be published on the Degree Course website (www.medschool.uniroma2.it). It will be possible to request a review of the list within 10 days of publication. After this date, the final and definitive ranking list will be published.

Art. 6 - The didactics

The teaching support activities will be carried out in the form of lessons, seminars, exam simulations, explanations on demand in the classroom by no later than 31st September 2019 unless derogations are otherwise stipulated. To be payed students must present a booklet where the done performances are listed (n. of hours, type of performance, students involved, topics, etc.).

Art. 7 - Collection of scholarships

Information regarding the relative distribution of the scholarships will be made available through a notice published on the website www.medschool.uniroma2.it of
