

CALL REGARDING THE AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY

Concerning the resolution dated 25/10/2021 of the Single Cycle Degree Course
in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata"

hereby announces

a selection, for the academic year 2022/2023, regarding the awarding of scholarships reserved to the students enrolled to the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata":

- N. 17 awards "Premio per Merito" of 500,00 euros for following integrated courses: Chemistry and Introductory Biochemistry, Physics and Statistics, Human Anatomy I, Histology and Embryology, Biology and Genetics, Human Anatomy II, Immunology and Immunopathology, Biochemistry, Physiology, Microbiology, Clinical Symptomatology, Laboratory Medicine, General Pathology and Pathophysiology, Human Sciences, Systemic Pathology I, Anatomic Pathology and Pharmacology. N. 1 scholarship will be assigned for each of the courses;
- N. 1 award of 1000,00 euros Web Abilities;
- N. 1 award of 800,00 euros for Social Manager activity (Facebook and Instagram)

Art. 1 - Requirements

Students who are entitled to participate must be regularly enrolled by 31/10/2022 and have an arithmetic average of the academic exams of at least 26/30. Marks obtained in other degree courses, other universities and during Erasmus periods will not be taken into consideration in the calculation of the average score.

Concerning the 17 awards "Premio per Merito", students can apply only for n. 1 integrated course, which must have been sustained at the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine

and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" within 24 months prior to the date of this call and regularly verbalised.

The following are excluded from the selection:

- students who have not paid and registered their university fees by the foreseen deadline;
- students who have been involved in disciplinary actions and/or have a criminal record.

The scholarships are compatible with the economical compensation received by part-time collaborations (ex-art. 2 of the D.M. 198/2003) and other scholarships for didactic and economical support, as well as with the exemption from the specific fee.

Art.2 - Calculation of the ranking list

For the purposes of the ranking relative to "Premio per Merito" , the following parameters will be taken into consideration, in order: A) the grade acquired in the exam relating to the course for which the application is being submitted; B) the overall arithmetic average of the exams; C) the total number of credits acquired at the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" at the date of this call. The ranking will be formulated in descending order; in the event of an ex aequo position, the student with the most recently verbalised exam will be selected. In case of further ex aequo position, the youngest student will be selected.

For the purposes of the ranking relative to the Web Activities activity, the following parameters will be taken into consideration, in order: A) the score obtained in a test administered by the didactic secretariat of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", designed to verify the candidate's knowledge regarding the management of websites; B) the overall arithmetic average of the exams; C) the total number of credits acquired at the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" at the date of this call. The ranking will be formulated in descending order; in the event of an ex aequo position, the youngest student will be selected.

For the purposes of the ranking relative to the Social Media activity, the following parameters will be taken into consideration: A) the overall arithmetic average of the exams; B) the total number of credits acquired at the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" at the date of this call. The ranking will be formulated in descending order; in the event of an ex aequo position, the youngest student will be selected.

Art. 3 - Commission

The ranking list will be formulated by a commission consisting of n. 3 professors of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" and a unit of administrative staff appointed by the Coordinator of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata".

Art. 4 - Application procedure

The application to participate to the selection, to the attention of the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", Prof. S. Marini, and of the Coordinator of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", Prof. L. Sarmati, written on plain paper in Italian or English as indicated below, must be sent by email as a PDF attachment to the address romiti@med.uniroma2.it by 00.00 of the 15/11/2022, making use of the self-certification according to the artt. 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 28.12.2000 n. 445. The scholarship award for which you are competing must be specified in the object of the email. In the application, the candidate must declare the following:

- a) name, surname, place and date of birth;
- b) fiscal code;
- c) to be enrolled to the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", specifying the exams verbalised by the date of this call and the overall arithmetic average. The self-certification is subjected to control by the university administration;
- d) to have never been involved in disciplinary sanctions;
- e) to not have a criminal record;
- f) the award for which the student is competing;
- g) only to students competing for didactic support activities, the subject for which they are applying;
- h) telephone number and email address;
- i) IBAN code of their bank account - no payments will be made to third parties;
- j) date and signature.

Art. 5 - Publishing of the ranking list

The three ranking lists will be published on the Degree Course website (www.medschool.uniroma2.it); it will be possible to request a review of the list within

10 days of publication. After this date, the final and definitive ranking lists will be published.

Art. 6 - Collection of the scholarships

Information regarding the distribution of the scholarships will be made available through the Degree Course website (www.medschool.uniroma2). Payments will be carried out upon termination of the classes of the ay 2022-23 with the nulla osta of the coordinator of the course by June 30th 2023.
