Since 2020, the Single-Cycle Degree in Medicine and Surgery automatically qualifies physicians to practice in Italy (D.L. n. 18, 17/03/2020, art. 102). The D.L. also grants the possibility to choose whether to pursue the qualifying license or the sole Academic title, up to the cohort of students first enrolled in a.y. 2019/2020; after that, for students first enrolled in a.y. 2020/2021 onwards, it will be compulsory to get the qualifying license together with the Degree.

Therefore, the **B2 certificate of Italian Language** will be compulsory for every student of the Single-Cycle Degree Course in “Medicine and Surgery” of the University of Rome “Tor Vergata” who cannot produce a native speaker certificate starting from those first enrolled in a.y. 2020/2021. Students first enrolled in previous aa.yy. will have to present such certificate only if they want to get the qualifying license.

The **deadline** is at the beginning of the fourth year (31st of October), with some exceptions:

- Cohort first enrolled in a.y. 2018/2019 and a.y. 2019/2020 (or previous aa.yy.): at the beginning of their sixth year, only if they want to get the qualifying license, along with the form “Richiesta di iscrizione al tirocinio per l’esame di stato per l’abilitazione alla professione di Medico Chirurgo”;
- Cohort first enrolled in a.y. 2020/2021: at the beginning of their sixth year, along with the form “Richiesta di iscrizione al tirocinio per l’esame di stato per l’abilitazione alla professione di Medico Chirurgo”.

The language certificates will be only accepted if issued by the following recognised bodies: *Università per gli Stranieri di Siena; Università per gli Stranieri di Perugia; Società Dante Alighieri; Università degli Studi di Roma Tre.*

ATTENTION

- 6th year students of the cohort first enrolled in a.y. 2020/2021 will not be allowed to graduate until they will produce such certificate
- 4th year students from the cohort first enrolled in a.y. 2021/2022 onwards will not be allowed to attend 4th year mandatory Clinical Practices until they will produce such certificate
- If 6th year students of the cohort first enrolled in a.y. 2018/2019 and a.y. 2019/2020 (or previous aa.yy.) will fail to produce such certificate, they will not be allowed to get the Surgical and Medical clerkship booklets and to follow the General Practitioner, in order to achieve the qualifying license
