

Academic Activities

Each year the MAC experience is unique, but always includes complete cadaver dissections, lectures, pro-section presentations, scrubs, equipment, accommodations, many meals and activities and complete cadaver dissection performed by the participants in our laboratory, the Anatomical Studies Laboratory of North America, located at The Charter Place, in Buffalo, NY.

Medical professionals provide lectures, demonstrations, and answer questions of participants,. Some use the lab time to determine the cause of death, to compare systems in the variety of cadavers and most importantly to master anatomy. American medical professions, education, and health care are also discussed. Pre- and post-conference exams are used to assess learning. Hard work is awarded with a certificate.

Mazzotti Anatomy Conferences (MACs)

The MACs began in 2010 earning international recognition and praise. Named for the President of the Bologna Medical School and of the European Federation for Experimental Morphology, the late Professor Giovanni Mazzotti that hoped to invite the best students from each of the Italian medical schools to participate and form relationships. Each year, hundreds of students apply and over 2200 have participated.



Travel

Many organize and travel with their classmates. Prior attendees utilized the Toronto airport (YYZ) 2 hours from Buffalo. The Buffalo airport (BUF) is close to TCP. A popular choice is roundtrip air from Italy (FCO) to New York City (JFK, EWR or LGA), then a round trip plane or train ticket to Buffalo. Some opt to stay in NYC (400 miles from Buffalo) at conference end. Some fly into Toronto and out of NYC. The Conference will pick you up at any Buffalo plane, train or bus station.



Accommodations and Meals

Accommodations at TCP are included in the conference fees for the dates listed. Early arrivals will need to arrange for other accommodations. TCP has several bunk beds per room, new shower facilities, a dining hall and lounging areas. Participants may choose their bunkmate; however little time will be allotted for sleeping.

TCP has ping-pong, Karaoke, musical instruments and a large video screen in our own performing arts center, the Tacoma Performing Arts Center (T-PAC), where lectures and some cultural events will be provided. Most meals are included, unless there is an offsite activity or free time, in our restaurant, the Grand Room. TCP is located in a welcoming Italian-American neighborhood, near a large park for running, golf, tennis, a zoo, restaurants, shops, a new Italian Cultural Center and a movie theater.



Application

The MAC 2023 Interest Survey should be completed as soon as possible. Please contact your Anatomy Professor to send us approval. Deposits secure participation. Tutors in Italy and administrators in Buffalo will assist. Airfare should not be purchased until a deposit is accepted by Chartered Professors. All are required to obtain health insurance of their choice and we suggest travel insurance to refund any conference fees you have paid in case vou cancel. Conference fee is determined by the costs to secure cadavers, faculty, staff, supplies and activities for all, therefore fees are non-refundable.



2023 MAC Fees

Conference fees of \$3150 for G1, G2 and G3 include complete cadaver dissection experiences, TCP accommodations, most meals and activities, and transportation to and from the Buffalo Airport (BUF), train or bus station. We will also arrange one transport to and from the Toronto airport (YYZ).
