

BONUS POINTS FOR THE CALCULATION OF THE FINAL DEGREE MARK
SINGLE CYCLE MASTER'S DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY

The following scores contribute to the calculation of the final degree mark, expressed out of 110:

- A) Simple arithmetic mean of all exam marks established in the study plan x 110 / 30
- B) Evaluation of the Thesis and the final examination performance: up to 7 points
- C) Bonus points based on objective parameters in function of the distinctive educational goals of the Course: up to 7 points

IN COURSE OR LATE GRADUATION (up to 3 points)	<i>3 points for "In Course Graduation" 1 point for "First Year Late Graduation"</i>
HONORS ("LODI") IN EXAM MARKS (up to 3 points)	<i>1 point for every three "Honors" ("Lodi") obtained in exam marks Participation in a Progress Test counts as one "Honor" ("Lode")</i>
ACTIVITIES ABROAD (up to 3 points)	<i>0.5 points for every two consecutive weeks spent abroad, only if the activity is officially approved by the Course or included in a defined project coordinated by a Course Professor and previously approved by the Degree Course Council (e.g., Erasmus+, Jay Nepal ONG, Mazzotti Conference)</i>
RESEARCH ACTIVITIES (up to 5 points)	<i>2 points for each participation in a publication (Peer Reviewed, PubMed) 0.5 points for each participation in an abstract as first author</i>
SCIENTIFIC AWARD (1 point)	
Candidates who have achieved a final mark greater than or equal to 111 may be awarded "Cum Laude" with the unanimous opinion of the Degree Examination Board

IN COURSE OR LATE GRADUATION (up to 3 points)	<i>3 points for "In Course Graduation" 2 points for "First Year Late Graduation"</i>
HONORS ("LODI") IN EXAM MARKS (up to 2 points)	<i>0.33 points for every "Honor" ("Lode") obtained in exam marks</i>
ACTIVITIES ABROAD (up to 4 points)	<i>- Up to 2 points for participation in Erasmus+ and/or Overseas (1 point: three to six months; 2 points: seven to twelve months)</i> <i>- 1 point for at least one month of stay abroad as part of solidarity medicine projects</i> <i>- 0.5 points for each week spent abroad, up to a maximum of 1 point for two weeks, as part of exchanges covered by the Course's international agreements (e.g., SISMI)</i>
RESEARCH ACTIVITIES	<i>1.5 points for each participation in a publication (Peer Reviewed, PubMed) 0.5 points for each participation in an abstract up to a maximum of 1 point</i>
EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (1 point)	<i>1 point for participation in at least twenty initiatives including seminars, conferences, training courses or similar, pertinent to the study plan and in any case additional to those recognized as ADO</i>
VOLUNTARY INTERNSHIP (up to 2 points)	<i>1 point for every three hundred hours of elective clinical internships (at hospitals or General Practitioners/Family Doctors) and/or research internships, other than those recognized as ADO</i>
Candidates who have achieved a final mark greater than or equal to 113 may be awarded "Cum Laude" with the unanimous opinion of the Degree Examination Board
