**CALL REGARDING THE AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS/TRAVELSHIPS AT "BUFFALO NY"**

Concerning the resolution dated 22/07/2025 of the Single Cycle Degree Course  
in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata"

**hereby announces**

a selection, for the academic year 2025/2026, regarding the awarding of n.4 scholarships/travelships of 3800,00 euros (all-inclusive of withholding taxes paid by the student and withholding taxes paid by the administration), reserved to students enrolled to the 2°, 3° and 4° year of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata". These scholarships are finalised at paying the attendance to the "Mazzotti Anatomy Conference 2025", from the 18<sup>th</sup> of July to the 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2026 (G1), at Buffalo (NY).

**Art. 1 - Requirements**

Students who are entitled to participate must be regularly enrolled in corso to the 2°, 3° or 4° year by 28/02/2026, have regularly taken and verbalized the exams of "Human Anatomy I" and "Human Anatomy II" and have an arithmetic average of the academic exams of at least 26/30. Marks obtained in other degree courses, other universities and during Erasmus periods will not be taken into consideration in the calculation of the average.

The following are excluded from the selection:

- students who have not paid and registered their university fees by the foreseen deadline;
- students who have been involved in disciplinary actions and/or have a criminal record.

The scholarships are compatible with the economical compensation received by part-time collaborations (ex-art. 2 of the D.M. 198/2003) and other scholarships for didactic and economical support, as well as with the exemption from the specific fee.

The awards are not compatible with scholarships and/or other benefits aimed at supporting the right to education granted by other public or private bodies/entities.

#### **Art.2 - Calculation of the ranking**

For the purposes of the ranking, the following parameters will be taken into consideration, in order: A) the arithmetic average of the marks obtained in the exams of "Human Anatomy I" and "Human Anatomy II"; B) the overall arithmetic average of the exams; C) the total number of credits acquired at the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" at the date of this call. In the case of a further *ex aequo* position, the youngest student will prevail. The ranking will be formulated in descending order; in case of renouncement of a winner, the scholarship will be assigned to the next candidate.

#### **Art. 3 - Commission**

The ranking will be established by a committee composed of two faculty members from the *Medicine and Surgery* program and one administrative staff member, appointed by the President of the Course. Approved by the CCdS on 27 January 2026 item 2.

#### **Art. 4 - Application procedure**

The application to participate to the selection, to the attention of the President of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", Prof.ssa L. Sarmati, written on plain paper in Italian or English as indicated below, must be sent by email as a PDF attachment to the address [romiti@med.uniroma2.it](mailto:romiti@med.uniroma2.it) by 6.00 pm of the 15/03/2026, making use of the self-certification according to the artt.46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 28.12.2000 n. 445. In the application, dated and signed, the candidates must declare the following:

- a) name, surname, place and date of birth;
- b) fiscal code;
- c) matricula number;
- d) to be enrolled in corso to the 2°, 3° or 4° year of the Single Cycle Degree Course in "Medicine and Surgery" of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", specifying the exams verbalised by the date of this call and the overall arithmetic average. The self-certification is subjected to control by the university administration;
- e) the arithmetic average of the exams of "Human Anatomy I" e "Human Anatomy II";
- f) to have never been involved in disciplinary sanctions;
- g) to not have a criminal record;
- h) telephone number and email address;
- i) IBAN code of their bank account - no payments will be made to third parties.

**Art. 5 - Publishing of the ranking list**

The ranking list will be published on the Degree Course website ([www.medschool.uniroma2.it](http://www.medschool.uniroma2.it)); it will be possible to request a review of the list within five days from the publication. After this date, the final and definitive ranking list will be published.

**Art. 6 - Scholarship collection**

Information regarding the disbursement of the scholarships will be made available through the Degree Course website ([www.medschool.uniroma2.it](http://www.medschool.uniroma2.it)). The payment will be dispensed upon presentation of an attendance certificate issued by the host structure.
