Publication Track record

Prof. Jannini's scientific activity is reflected in his **> 350 full papers** published in peer-reviewed international journals (**total impact factor: >600; cited >12000 times; H-index: 63, according to Scopus, and 76, according to Google scholar**), including high-impact international journals such as the *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, USA, Endocrine Reviews, Nature Review Urology, Molecular Endocrinology* and the *Journal of Clinical Endocrinology & Metabolism*. His main research interests are sexual medicine, andrology (erectile dysfunction and subcellular localization of type 5 phosphodiesterase; pathophysiology of premature ejaculation; functional anatomy of female orgasm), and psychoneuroendocrinology of reproduction and sexuality, in particular, the opiate and serotonergic pathways, testosterone and thyroid pathophysiology in the control of sexual activity; molecular localization and the role of the nuclear thyroid hormone receptor in the male genital tract. He conducts his research in endocrinology, andrology, and sexual medicine both from a clinical and a basic perspective employing molecular, clinical and psychometric tools. On the strength of his publications, he is listed in the top three authors in the field of premature ejaculation (Hui J et al. *Int J Impot Res*, 2020), in the top ten authors in the field of erectile dysfunction (Hui J et al. *Int J Impot Res*, 2019), and, on the basis of his citation metrics, in the list of worldwide 100.000 scientists (Ioannidis JPA et al., *Plos Biol*, 2019), as well in the classification of the Top Italian Scientists (<http://www.topitalianscientists.org>). Finally, Prof. Jannini is active in promoting education in sexual medicine and public sexual health worldwide and a recipient of several public and private research grants.

Prizes and awards: the Valerio Monesi Fellowship for Research in Reproduction (1987), the Becton Dickinson Award of the Italian Society of Endocrinology (1992), the First Award of the European Academy of Andrology (2000), the prize for the best Special Issue of the *Journal of Endocrinological Investigation* (2004), and the XXV Ottorino Rossi Award from the "Mondino" Neurologic Institute, Pavia (2014). In 2023, he received the Career Award of the European Society of Sexual Medicine (ESSM), the most prestigious ESSM prize given in recognition of achievements by senior researchers in the field of sexual medicine.
